Domain is designed to reinforce existing context through four key measures.

First, a large setback provides ample sidewalk space for pedestrian movement, retail merchandising and sidewalk dining as well as landscaping to help mitigate the scale of the building; second, a three-story portal and plaza—strategically placed as a visual connection from the historic Formosa Café to the Hollywood Hills—breaks

down the façade scale and opens communal life to the street; third, the introduction of smaller scale massing along residential streets, and; fourth, the gradual stepping down of the building, transitioning to adjacent smaller scale multi-family properties.
